FIRE RESPONSE FROM THE DEACONS

The Deacons Benevolence Team has been working hard to determine how best to care for our church family affected by the Spokane fires.

We are forming teams of Deacons, Elders, and volunteers to reach out to affected families and learn what they need. One of these is our Adopt-a-Family team, which matches families with practical help such as grocery runs, transportation, minor property repairs—including fence rebuilding—and pet care. A Deacon will coordinate each team, with Benevolence Fund support as needed. If you would like to serve in this way, we would love to have you.

We will also put out a call for clothing donations once we know which sizes and types are needed most. Please keep an eye out for that update.
